New Delhi, the April, 2024.

**S.O.------(E).**—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-sections (1) and (2) of section 16 read with section 17 and sub-section (3) of section 25 of the Bureau of Indian Standards Act, 2016 (11 of 2016), the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary so to do in the public interest and after consulting the Bureau of Indian Standards, hereby makes the following Order, namely:-

- 1. Short title and commencement.** – (1) This Order may be called the Indutech (Quality Control) Order, 2024.  
(2) It shall come into force immediately after ..... (i.e. one hundred and eighty days from the date of its publication in the Official Gazette).
- 2. Application.** – This Order shall apply to goods or article specified in column (2) of the Schedule annexed to this Order, but shall not apply to such goods or article meant for export.
- 3. Compulsory use of Standard Mark.** – The goods or article specified in column (2) of the said Schedule shall conform to the corresponding Indian Standard specified in column (3) thereof and shall bear the Standard Mark under a licence from the Bureau of Indian Standards in accordance with Scheme-I of Schedule-II to the Bureau of Indian Standards (Conformity Assessment) Regulations, 2018.
- 4. Certifying and enforcement authority.** – The Bureau of Indian Standards shall be the certifying and enforcing authority in respect of the goods or article specified in column (2) of the said Schedule.
- 5. Penalty for contravention.** – Any person, who contravenes the provisions of this Order, shall be punishable in accordance with the provisions of the Bureau of Indian Standards Act, 2016 (11 of 2016).
