## Promoting Green & Sustainable Production

- ✓ 50% capital subsidy or INR 5 crore whichever is less for establishment of Effluent Treatment Plants (ETPs)
- ✓ 50% of eligible civil infrastructure/ plant & machinery cost up to a maximum of INR 10 Crore for setting up of ZLD plants.
- ✓ 50% capital subsidy or INR 1 crore, whichever is less will be provided for setting up of common steam generation plant.
- ✓ Subsidy @ 50% or INR 2 crore, whichever is less, for new projects setup exclusively for recycling of old textile products.
- ✓ Capital subsidy equivalent to the subsidy provided for 12 months' worth of electricity subsidy will be given to the solar energy projects.
