BE @ Penang returns for its 5th edition with a theme that urges the industry, the businesses, the players and professionals to be fearless and bold in charting the path to success no matter what crisis comes their way.

When COVID-19 hit Malaysia and the Movement Control Order (MCO) was imposed on 16 March 2020, business events together with tourism took a huge hit. With almost zero business for 2 months and a slow and painful recovery post-MCO, the industry banded together to work on a recovery plan for the immediate and near future.

In July 2020, PCEB unveiled the Business Events Penang Rejuvenation Plan 2021 – 2023 charting the recovery plan and strategies for the business events industry. The plan is built on 3 thrusts: collaboration, digitalisation and education.

The first initative that was launched is the Next Normal Guidelines for Business Events Penang that was brought together through the collaboration between industry leaders and contributors from 6 main sectors.

In terms of education, the BE @ Penang conference plays a big part in providing a platform for industry partners to participate in knowledgeable sessions by industry professionals and upskill themselves while putting what was shared into practice at their organisations.

BE @ Penang 2020 is designed with these 3 thrusts as its foundation, and virtually brings together industry leaders from around the world here for an intensive two-days of knowledge-sharing and networking.

The theme of this year's edition is BE INEVITABLE. It is a call of action to business events industry partners to be strong, bold, fearless and become a force to be reckoned with as leaders and industry experts in charting the path to success no matter what crisis comes their way.
